INDIA - GOLDEN TRIANGLE TOUR 4 NIGHTS/5 DAYS

Day 1 - Arrival in Delhi (D)

Met on arrival at New Delhi Airport by our local representative and transferred to your designated Hotel. Following lunch at a local restaurant, proceed on a sightseeing tour including the **Akshar Dham Temple** (closed on Mondays), **Rajghat** - Cremation Palace of Mahatma Gandhi, **India Gate**, a 42 meter high stone arch built as a memorial in honour of the Indian soldiers who fought in World War 1 and the Afghan War, the **President House** (built in 1929), former imperial residence of the British Viceroy and now the official residence of the President of the Indian Republic, **India's Parliament House**, a spectacular circular shaped building housing the Lok Sabha (Lower House Chambers) and Rajya Sabha (Upper House Chambers). Evening at leisure or for shopping. Overnight in Delhi

Day 2 - Delhi - Agra (B/D)

After Breakfast at the hotel proceed to **Agra**. Check in to your hotel and proceed on a sightseeing tour of Agra. Visit one of the world's most popular monuments, the **Taj Mahal** (closed on Fridays) built by Mughal Emperor Shah-Jehan for his Empress Mumtaz Mahal. The construction of Taj Mahal is believed to have taken 22 years with over 20,000 craftsmen working round the clock. Continue the tour with a visit to the magnificent **Agra Fort** built on the



banks of River Yamuna. Be impressed by the diversity in architecture of monuments within the Fort built by Mughal Emperors. In the evening, visit a **handicraft and textile industry factory**, followed by a **shopping spree** in Government approved establishments for traditional souvenirs and gifts. Agra is known for its fabulous **marble handicrafts** with intricate soft stone inlay carvings. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 - Agra - Jaipur (B/D)

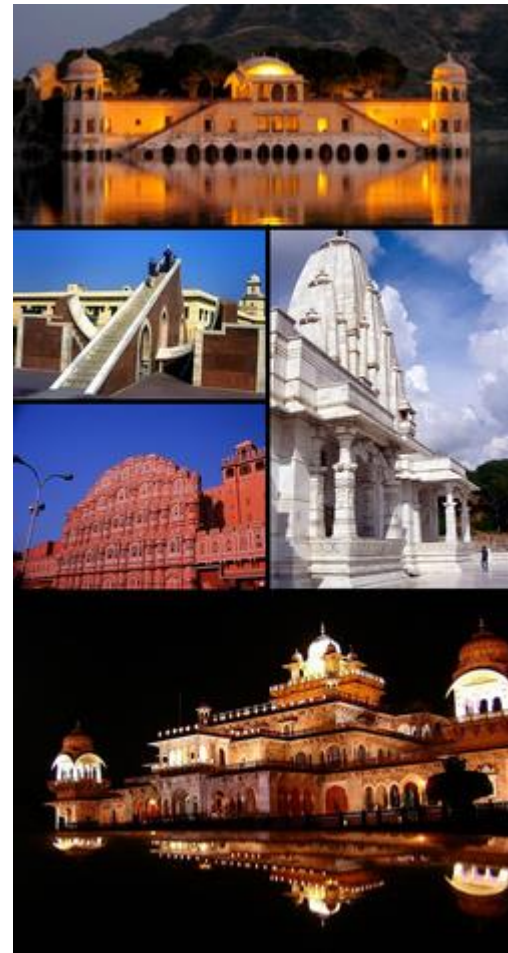
After an early breakfast at the hotel set out to **Jaipur**, the Pink city. En-route, we will visit the **Fatehpur Sikri**, a deserted city of sandstone with nine enormous gates within which a number of palaces, meeting halls and sprawling courtyards exist. Check in at the hotel in Jaipur for an afternoon rest. Late afternoon city tour will include visits to the Hindu **Birla Temple (Laxmi Narayan Temple)**, known for its intricate pure white marble carvings, located on an elevated ground at the base of Moti Dungari hill; the **City Palace**, the principle residence of the former ruling family, which is renowned for its stunning architecture. The City Palace includes the museum, courtyards and several beautifully laid out gardens. Return to your hotel for Dinner and Overnight.

Day 4 - Jaipur - Delhi (B/D)

After an early Breakfast at the hotel we will set out on our drive back to Delhi. En-route we will visit the **Amer Fort**, the principal tourist attraction in the Jaipur area. Marvel **the Fort Palace** constructed in 1652 by Raja Mansingh and later extended and completed by the Jai Singh. Enjoy an **elephant ride** while climbing up to the Amer Fort. Visit **Jal Mahal Palace** set in the middle of Man Sagar Lake and the **Hawa Mahal** (Palace of the Wind) constructed with red and pink sandstone and consisting a high screen wall built around so that the women of the Royal family could observe street festivals while unseen from the outside. Proceed on to Delhi with a lunch stop en-route. Check in at the Hotel in Delhi and spend the rest of the day at leisure or you could indulge in some shopping. Overnight in Delhi

Day 5 - Delhi - Departure (B)

Day at leisure until departure to the airport.
