DAY 1 - AIRPORT-NEGOMBO



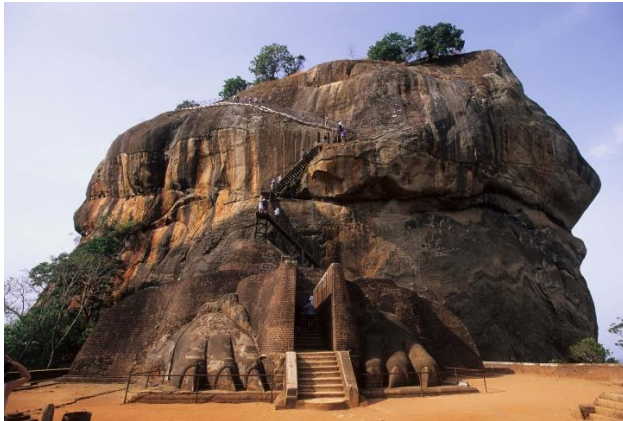
You will be met on arrival at the Bandaranaike International Airport by our Local Representative and your Chauffeur/Guide. Take a leisurely drive to Negombo. Relax and unwind at the Ayurveda Centre of your hotel. Later, take a brief tour of the City and if time permits, enjoy a boat ride along the Dutch canals or simply laze on the golden sandy beach. Overnight in Negombo.

DAY 2 – NEGOMBO-SIGIRIYA



Set off to experience Sri Lanka's inland delights. Enjoy the picturesque journey through farming villages, rice paddy fields and the towering statue of Buddha upon a huge rock in Kurunegala. Arrive at your accommodation - your very own Chalet built upon stilts overlooking the wetland providing a perfect sense of peace and tranquility, its design inspired by local and rural traditions.

DAY 3 – SIGIRIYA



Enjoy the day at your Chalet, one of the twenty-five (some have their own private plunge pool) spread across a vast wetland. At your leisure, mount the Sigiriya Rock Fortress, considered as the 8th wonder of the world.

DAY 4 – SIGIRIYA - KANDY

Proceed to Kandy, the hill capital of Sri Lanka surrounded by virgin forests and the meandering Mahaweli River. Take a City tour of Kandy including the market place and a visit to the Temple of the Tooth Relic. Late evening, enjoy a Sri Lankan Cultural Dance Performance. Overnight in Kandy



DAY 5 – KANDY



Spend a lazy day at your contemporary all suite property. Dip in the pool looking down to the city of Kandy. Take a guided tour through the lush Royal Botanical Gardens of Peradeniya for an introduction to tropical flora. Overnight in Kandy.

DAY 6 – KANDY-HATTON



Proceed on a scenic drive to Hatton relishing the endless views of tea carpeted valleys with female tea pluckers picking their way through the vast tea plantations. En-route, visit the Bogawantalawa Tea Estate, known as the Golden Valley of Tea. As you ascend to Hatton, make your way into your accommodation for the next couple of days – a beautiful colonial bungalow restored from the time of the Sri Lankan Raj. You will be greeted by your very own personal butler who will attend to you throughout your stay in Hatton, and your Executive Chef with whom you could plan your menu options for a mouth-watering culinary experience. Overnight in Hatton.

DAY 7 - HATTON



Take a guided walk with the Resident Tea Planter through the tea plantation and follow the trail of the planters of old Ceylon. Watch the Tea Pluckers in action and continue to the factory to experience the process of creating World-famous Sri Lanka (Ceylon) tea. Taste the different grades of this great brew before returning to your bungalow. Rest of the afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Hatton.

DAY 8 - HATTON-WADDUWA



Proceed to Wadduwa, a seaside resort set amidst a large coconut grove with incredible views of the Indian Ocean. En-route to the idyllic coast, you will pass through hills to meandering rivers and farms.

DAY 9 - WADDUWA

Marvel at the raw beauty of Sri Lanka's coast spending a carefree day. As you step out in the golden sandy beach of Wadduwa, do not be surprised if your footprints are one of the few as the beach is fairly private giving you seclusion and privacy. Overnight in Wadduwa.

DAY 10 - WADDUWA

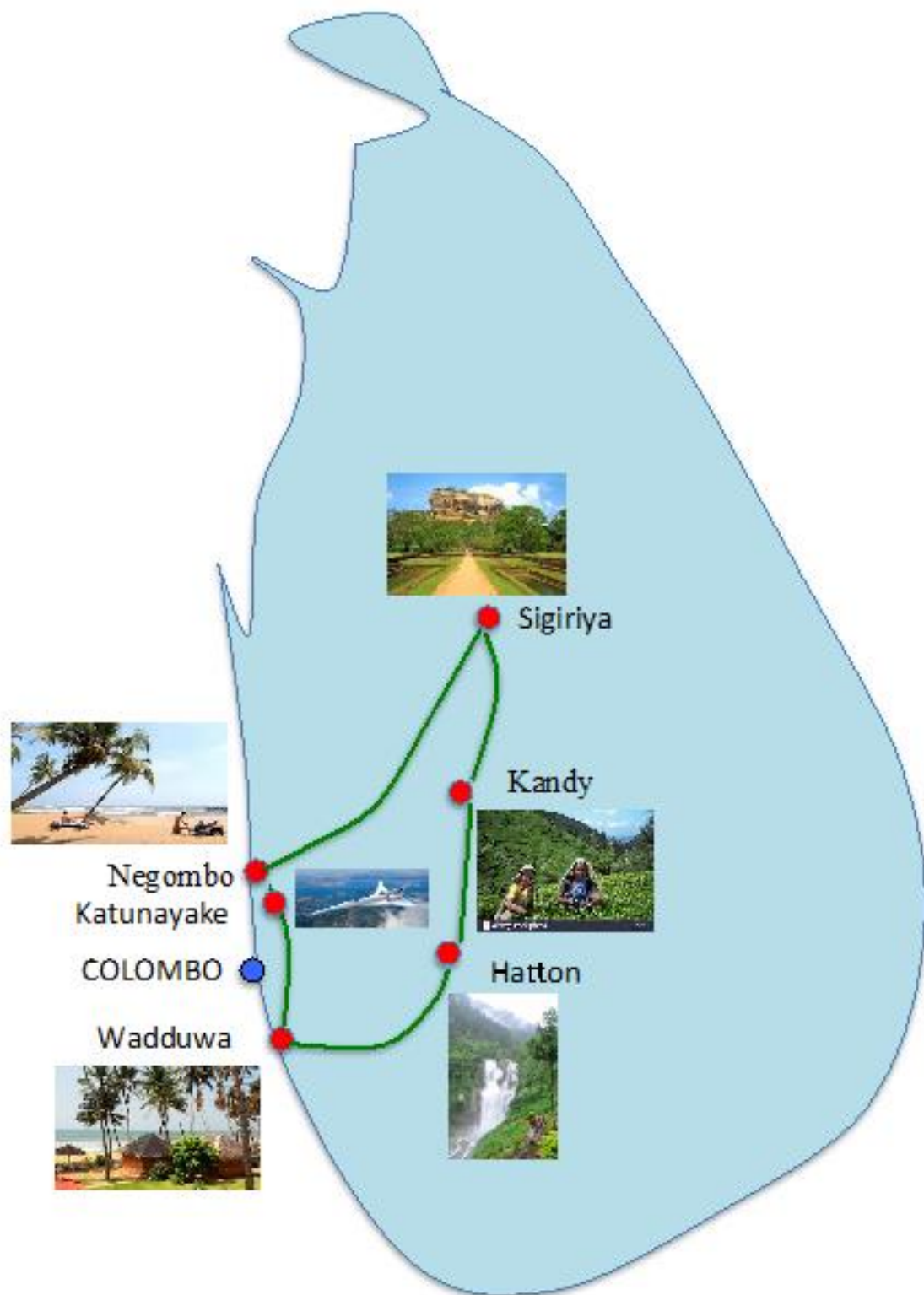
At leisure.
